

Community First Choice
(CFC)

Community First Choice is a new Medicaid program in Colorado that expands access to **In-Home Support Services (IHSS)** for eligible individuals



Benefits to the Family

**Available to eligible adults and children*

Eligible family members can become an IHSS attendant and provide:

- **Personal Care** - New Acquisition, Maintenance, and Enhancement of Skills (AME) task (personal care for teaching and instruction).
- **Homemaker** - New (AME) task.
- **Health Maintenance Activities** - Member-directed skilled care option.

Who Qualifies?

- Enrolled in Health First Colorado, meet an institutional level of care (LOC), and have an assessed need for a CFC service(s).
- Enrolled in an HCBS waiver program, receiving at least one waiver service per month, and have an assessed need for a CFC service(s).

Family Member as CNA
(Certified Nursing Aide)

Become your **loved one’s caregiver as a CNA** while supporting your family as a PASCO employee



Benefits to the Family

- Eligible family members can become a CNA and be paid as a PASCO employee to provide care to their loved one.
- PASCO will pay for CNA school for up to two caregivers.

Who Qualifies?

- Eligibility is determined by Health First Colorado (Medicaid) standards and specific criteria for receiving CNA services.

Why PASCO?

- PASCO offers a reliable 24/7 on-call and back-up team, available to assist with care as necessary.
- PASCO nurses provide supervision and make regular visits to address inquiries and monitor any potential changes in health condition, as well as determine the the need for increased care.

Pediatric Personal Care
(PPC)

This program provides relief for a parent and can pay someone you trust, a friend or relative, to provide care as a PASCO employee



Benefits to the Family

- A family-provided Personal Care Worker will assist with care tasks like bathing, feeding, and hygiene.
- Your child will receive supports tailored to their individual needs.
- Encourage self-reliance in your child while granting you additional time to focus on yourself or engage with other family members.

Who Qualifies?

- Eligibility is determined by a physician’s recommendation for personal care supports.
- PASCO coordinate the necessary documentation through Health First Colorado (Medicaid).

Why PASCO?

- PASCO provides paid training for your personal care worker, as well as regular oversight of the care being provided.
- PASCO handles all administrative functions.

Intellectual or Developmental
Disabilities (I/DD)

Support services for children and adults, including expertise in navigating the transition to adulthood



Benefits to the Family

- Eligible family members can become caregivers for their loved one.
- Individuals can remain in their homes with services and supports that allow for community integration.
- Services include residential habilitation services and supports, community connector, respite, specialized day habilitation, personal care, homemaking, mentorship and more.
- Transition Support - educational events, resources, and knowledgeable staff available to assist with the transition to adulthood.

Who Qualifies?

- Available to individuals on Health First Colorado (Medicaid) qualifying waivers.
- Children’s Habilitation Residential Program Waiver (CHRP).

- Children’s Extensive Support (CES).

- Supported Living Services (SLS).

- Develiopmental Disabilities (DD).

Why PASCO?

- Family members can be paid as PASCO employees to provide service and supports as Direct Service Providers (DSP).
- Focus on quality of life with PASCO as an advocate and advisor.

Private Duty Nursing (PDN)

Provide support for your loved one with high-level care needs as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) or Registered Nurse (RN)



Benefits to the Family

- Family caregivers who are LPNs or RNs can provide nursing care to their loved ones in the comfort of their own home.
- Assurance that the client is receiving the best possible care.
- Services include continuous nursing care over extended periods of time.

Who Qualifies?

- Individuals who require continuous skilled nursing services and assessment.
- Clients are technology dependent
 - Examples include: feeding pump, oxygen, mechanical ventilation, trach with ongoing suctioning, BiPAP, CPAP, and more.
- Clients are able to be safely served in the comfort of their home.

Why PASCO?

- Excellent medical management and care coordination.
- Highly trained nurses on staff.
- Family members or friends that are LPNs or RNs may be eligible to be hired to deliver care.
- RN and LPN recruitment services offered
- LPN scholarship opportunities available.
